Today, 28TH July, 2022, Mr. Hugo Rodríguez,
candidate for the position of Ambassador of
the United States of North America before
the People and Government of the Republic
of Nicaragua, during the confirmation
hearing of the Senate Foreign Relations
Committee, made interventionist and
disrespectful statements against our

country, ignoring the Principles of International Law, the Charter of the United Nations and the Vienna Convention on Diplomatic Relations.

The Government of Nicaragua, in use of its powers and in exercise of its National Sovereignty, immediately withdraws the pláacet granted to candidate Hugo Rodríguez.

We reiterate that every diplomat has the duty to contribute to respect and understanding between Peoples and Governments, that is, between the Human Community. We recall that based on diplomacy and in compliance with the postulates of the Vienna Convention, an Ambassador or candidate for Ambassador, cannot get involved in national issues that are specific to Nicaraguans and much less disrespect, offend, humiliate, threaten,

lead or be a factor of interference or interventionism, in the internal affairs of our country.
